**Glenn Cunningham Inducted into Ohio Veterans Hall of Fame**

Glenn Cunningham will be remembered for many things: Being a policeman, community leader and veteran. He died Feb. 2, 2006, but recently was inducted into the Ohio Veterans Hall of Fame for his service to his country and the myriad things he did for Newark and Licking County. The Ohio Veterans Hall of Fame has inducted more than 900 veterans since its inception in 1992.

Each year the committee, made up of representatives from Ohio's veterans organizations, selects 20 inductees who served their country honorably in a branch of military service and continued to serve their communities, state and nation after discharge.

A 1963 graduate of Newark High School, Cunningham served in the Air Force from 1963-66 and on the Newark police department from 1967-1994.

For the next six years, he was the director of security at Newark High School and a reserve officer serving as captain and chief for the police department. He battled cancer starting in 1979, when he had to have a liver transplant from his mother as a result of polycystic kidney disease. He had oral surgery four times between 1998 and 2005, resulting in the loss of 40 percent of his tongue and all of his teeth. Additional cancer caused the amputation of his left index finger.

Cunningham's accomplishments: Cunningham contributed to the community through his involvement with numerous veterans organizations, including American Legion Post 85, VFW Post 1060, AMVETS Post 345, and as a commissioner in the Licking County Veterans' Service Commission. He also was a charter member of Point Man Ministries of Licking County and a member of the Fraternal Order of Police 127, Newark Bicentennial Committee and Newark Jaycees, among other organizations. He also formed the Police Athletic League in 1991.

We should all be honored for this prestigious recognition for Glenn and proud that he served our organization as honorably as he did and represented us well.
