Work Day at the LCFOP#127

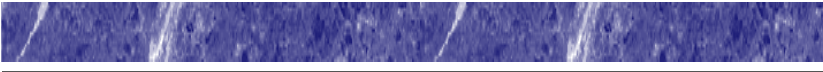
